

THE TERMS OF PARTICIPATION
in the third All-Russian
Jewelry and Stone Carving Art Contest in Kaliningrad

A curator has right to present works of not less than 5 and not more than 15 authors for the contest. Each artist presents not more than 3 works or sets\compositions for one nomination. Works should be made only in 2015 to 2016. All the materials are allowed to use in presented for the competitive works. **Every work is handed in to the Organizing Committee marked with a label of name, year of creation, used materials and techniques on it.**

The given works will be exposed in the Kaliningrad Amber Museum **from June 20 to September 04, 2016. Works are given back to authors after the end of the exhibition.**

Results of the contest are summed up by the competent jury, who is selected by the Organizing Committee of the contest. Jury members can't be participants or curators of the contest.

The Kaliningrad Amber Museum will consider the possibility of purchase of the works noticed by jury of the contest for its collection.

The contest is open to authors who are the curators, as well as independent artists. **Independent artists are financially responsible for themselves.** The Organization Committee has the right to a preliminary selection of works of independent artists.

Independent participants must submit the following materials:

- information about themselves on the Application form;
- drive with signed photos (minimum resolution is 300 dpi) of work, which must be sent to the Kaliningrad Amber Museum **until May 10, 2016** (photo by e-mail will not be accepted!);
- personal photo for publication in the catalog (minimum resolution is 300 dpi);
- copies of diplomas, certificates or other documents on education; copies of diplomas, certificates, diplomas or other documents for participation in exhibitions and competitions, and awards; copies of publications indicating the bibliographic data;
- works for the contest until June 16, 2016.
